Reminders about each day

In Terms 1 and 4, all children will be required to bring a hat from home to wear outside. This is a nonnegotiable. Please ensure your child has a <u>named</u> <u>hat</u> in their bag every day. A spare hat could also be kept at school in their personal tote tray. We also ask that you apply sunblock on your child each morning.

Children can bring a named water bottle each day. Please bring enough food to ensure your child has enough to eat for three eating times: a healthy snack, morning tea, and lunch.

Please have devices charged and placed on the shelves at the beginning of each day.

We love to celebrate your child's birthday alongside them, but we kindly ask that you not send your child to school with lollies to share with others due to the large number of tamariki and dietary needs in our

space.
